# **Outline**

## Pre-requisite

Some knowledge of European cinema. Some knowledge of at least one European language other than English and any theoretical background in sciences or humanities will be indeed an advantage.

#### **Aim**

To enable students to work in a multidisciplinary area and acquire a philosophical perspective of contemporary cinema.

## **Intended Learning Outcomes**

To provide students with a practical and formal way to approach the cinematographic culture in which we live in. Students will be encouraged to create an independent capability of analysis and writing production.

## **Learning/Teaching Methods**

Students will be asked to design at the beginning of the course a basic bibliography (initially based on the information provided by the lecturer) according with his/her expectations and preferences and they will consequently be expected to explore that material to produce the final essay.
